The Decco S.A. company is soliciting for financing the project called:

'Implementation of design strategy by Decco S.A. for the purpose of introduction of innovative PVC profiles in the market' and therefore

Enquiry for quotation in accordance with the principle of competitiveness.
The Contracting Party acknowledges the possibility of holding negotiations.
Procurement within the framework of project entitled **'Implementation of design strategy by Decco S.A. for the purpose of introduction of innovative PVC profiles in the market'**, carried out under Measure 1.4 'Design for Competition', Priority Axis 1: 'Entrepreneurial Eastern Poland' of Operational Programme Eastern Poland 2014-2020.

3. Description of the Object of Contract.

Extrusion line for glassbead profile PCV , which includes :

- 1. Twin screw conical extruder for PCV profiles (dryblend), extruder output in terms of 55 – 150 kg/h .**
- 2. Calibration table of length approx. 6mb .**
- 3. Haul off and cutting device, of maximal profile width 150mm and height 100mm.**
- 5. Profile table adapted to lay down profiles of length approx. 6,5 mb.**
- 6. Co – Extruder to produce glassbead profile gaskets, made of soft PCV (granulate), extruder output in terms of 25 kg/h.**

8. Description of tender participation requirements and manner of evaluation of compliance with such requirements.

8.1In order to participate in the proceedings, the Contractors must comply with the following requirements:

a. have authorisation to conduct business or specific activities within the scope corresponding to the object of the contract

8.2 Compliance with the tender participation requirements shall be evaluated as compliant / non-compliant based on the information included in the documents and statements submitted by the Contractors

The date of receiving the bid by the Contracting Party shall be recognised as the date of bid submission. Bids submitted after expiry of this deadline shall not be considered.

13. Bid validity period.

The Contractor shall be bound by the bid for the period of 60 days. The bid validity period shall start with expiry of the tender submission deadline.

14. Tender opening date and place.

Tender opening shall take place on 28.04.2017 at 17.00 in the premises of the Contracting Party. The Contracting Party does not provide for public tender opening.

15. Bid evaluation criteria and description of the manner of criteria calculation.

The obtained marks shall be rounded to two decimal places. The Contracting Party shall award the contract to the Contractor whose bid complies with all terms and requirements and who receives the highest number of points.

In the event of stating the value of the object of contract in a foreign currency, conversion to PLN shall be made according to the average exchange rate of the National Bank of Poland as of the tender opening date.

16. The scope of amendments to the agreement concluded as a result of the proceedings:

The Contracting Party shall reserve the right to hold negotiations in order to reduce the price of the concluded agreement, change the payment terms or change the contract delivery dates. It is allowed to introduce minor changes related to the contract that do not affect the value of the concluded agreement. Any amendments of the provisions of the concluded agreement can be made upon the consent of both parties expressed in writing, or else shall be null and void.

17. Any entities affiliated in capital or personally with the Contracting Party cannot participate in the proceedings.

Capital or personal relations shall be understood as mutual relations between the beneficiary or individuals authorised to incur obligations on behalf of the beneficiary, or individuals performing on behalf of the beneficiary activities related to preparation and conduct of the procedure of selecting the Contractor and the Contractor, consisting in particular in:

- a) participation in a company as a partner of a civil partnership or partnership;
- b) possession of at least 5% of shares or stocks;
- c) performance of the function of a member of the supervisory or management body, attorney, proxy;
- d) being in a legal or factual relation that may raise reasonable doubts concerning impartiality in selection of the contractor, in particular being
- e) married, or in a relationship of kinship or affinity directly or collaterally to the second degree, or in the relation of adoption, custody or guardianship.

18. Other information.

By submitting a bid, the Bidder agrees to notify other bidders about the bid details. The Bidder shall have the right to refuse to publish technical details of the object of contract.

The Contracting Party hereby reserves the right to:

- 1) change the terms of contract awarding in accordance with Item 15,
- 2) annul the proceedings,
- 3) fail to select any of the submitted bids without stating the reason,
- 4) leave a bid unprocessed if it is non-compliant with the requirements of this enquiry for quotation. In the event of occurrence of the above circumstances, the Bidders shall not be entitled to any claims against the Contracting Party. The Contracting Party hereby informs that the proceedings are not carried out pursuant to the Public Procurement Act of 29 January 2004, therefore it is not possible to apply means of appeal specified in this Act.
